

## **EU Tightened Up Lead Migration Limits For Toys**

*Council Directive (EU) 2017/738* was recently adopted by the Council of the EU as amendment to Annex II of Directive 2009/48/EC on safety of toys. Accordingly the migration limits for lead in toys and components of toys shall be reduced with effect from 28 October 2018.

Lead (mg/kg)	<b>Cat I</b> Dry, brittle, powder-like or pliable toy material	<b>Cat II</b> Liquid or sticky toy material	Cat III Scraped-off toy material
Current migration limit	13.5	3.4	160
NEW migration limit *effective on 2018/10/28	2.0	0.5	23

Toys manufactured and/or imported into the EU shall be in compliance with the new requirements, demonstrated through conformity assessment either to a EU harmonized standard, e.g. EN71-3 (to be revised as shown below) or to the related laws, regulations and administrative provisions of the Member States published by 28 October 2018.
