Part 3 Added to EN for Child Care Articles – **Wheeled Child Conveyances**

The European Standard EN 1888 series consisted originally of 2 parts, specifying the safety requirements and test methods for pushchairs designed for the carriage of one or more children.

On 10 July 2024, European Committee for Standardization (CEN) published a Part 3 to this series referenced: EN 1888-3:2024, titled: "Child care articles - Wheeled child conveyances - Part 3: Pushchairs intended for leisure sport activities".

This new part specifies the safety requirements of pushchairs when used for running / jogging or skating (excluding ice skating), intended for the transport of one or two children up to 15 or 22 kg each.
