EU Updated Harmonised Standards to Comply with the Toy Safety Directive

On 2021-11-15, the European Commission published "Implementing Decision (EU) 2021/1992" on harmonised standards in support of the Toy Safety Directive 2009/48/EC (TSD).

The Decision, repealing the previous issues including (EU) 2021/867, is to update the list of harmonised standards for presumption of conformity with the corresponding essential requirements set out in the TSD.
